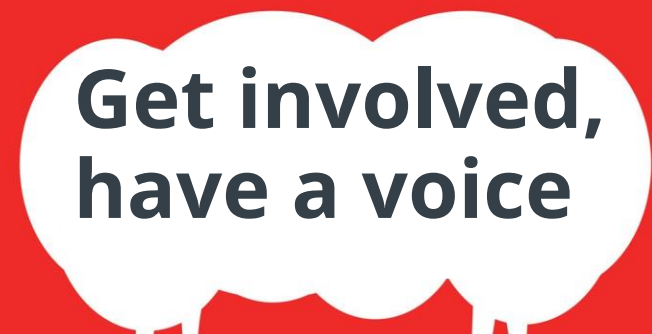

Tenant engagement is all about working together with our tenants and communities to address the issues that are a priority for them.

It's important to help you, as a tenant, feel empowered. It also promotes a culture of mutual trust, respect and partnership between tenants and the council.

Getting involved

We want to hear from you about what we are doing well as a landlord, and what we can do better.

Through different tenant engagement opportunities, you can have your say on our services. It's your opportunity to inform and influence decision making, promote best practice and ensure that services continue to meet the standards you expect.

Get in touch with us and get involved if you want to:

Work with us to inform and influence change

Have a say on issues affecting your home and community

Support other tenants or residents

Pursue issues of interest, such as addressing anti-social behaviour or environmental improvements

Be informed about how the housing service is performing

There are a number of ways you can get involved:

- ▮ **Surveys** - give your views and help shape our services. This can be done online, by phone or by post.
- ▮ **Community litter picks** - join us at one of our community litter picks across the borough.
- ▮ **Estate inspectors** - help us inspect and survey areas of Chesterfield. Full training will be provided.
- ▮ **Focus groups and working groups** - share your opinion on a specific topic or policy as part of a one-off meeting or a short series of meetings.
- ▮ **Communication and accessibility group** - help shape how we provide information and communicate with tenants. Face to face and online meetings.
- ▮ **Tenant inspectors** - carry out structured tasks, such as inspecting empty properties. Full training will be provided.
- ▮ **Performance group** - join other tenants and council officers to review how the service is performing.
- ▮ **Tenant challenge panel (TCP)** - help to scrutinise housing services and make recommendations for improvement.
- ▮ **Housing advisory board** - help to inform decision making along with staff, Councillors and other tenants
