

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

PUBLIC PATH ORDER 2024**


The above Order was made on the 16th day of February 2024. The effect of the Order will be to stop up bridleway 48 and lengths of other public footpaths and diversion of public footpaths 1, 50 and 71. This is necessary as the result of the proposed ongoing restoration of Chesterfield Canal (for which planning permission has been granted) and to provide for alternative and connected bridleways and footpaths. The new routes of the bridleways and footpaths will be created with widths and surfacing as described in the Order.

A copy of the Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge at the Customer Services Centre, Town Hall, Chesterfield between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. Mondays to Fridays or may be viewed at www.chesterfield.gov.uk.

Any representation about or objection to the Order may be sent or delivered in writing addressed to the Head of Regulatory Law, Town Hall, Rose Hill, Chesterfield, S40 1LP not later than 29th March 2024 or regulatory.law@chesterfield.gov.uk. Please state the grounds on which it is made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, Chesterfield Borough Council may itself confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
