NOTICE OF DISCHARGE OF THE CHESTERFIELD BOROUGH COUNCIL

Dog Control Order DC01 2011– dog fouling is not permitted in cemeteries (Boythorpe, Brimington, Spital and Staveley).

Dog Control Order DC02 2011– dogs must be kept on a lead at cemeteries (Boythorpe, Brimington, Spital and Staveley).

Dog Control Order DC03 2011 - requiring the removal of faeces on all public open spaces.

Dog Control Order DC04 2013– dog exclusion zone at Eastwood Park, Hasland.

Dog Control Order DC05 2013– dogs must be on a lead at Eastwood Park, Hasland.

Dog Control Order DC06 2013– dogs on leads by direction at Eastwood Park, Hasland (when requested by an authorised officer).

TAKE NOTICE that the above mentioned Dog Control Orders (the provisions of which by virtue of section 75(3) of the Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 were treated as being provisions of a public spaces protection order with effect from 20 October 2017) have been discharged and cease to have effect on 16 July 2018.

A new order, named The Public Spaces Protection Order Chesterfield (No 1) 2018, which relates to the control of dogs in public places within the Borough of Chesterfield has been made and comes into effect on 16 July 2018.
