1. Forms of nomination for the Borough Election may be obtained from the Returning Officer, Town Hall, Rose Hill, Chesterfield, Derbyshire, S40 1LP who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area prepare a nomination paper for signature.
2. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer, Room 1.24, Town Hall, Rose Hill, Chesterfield, Derbyshire, S40 1LP, by appointment only from 10.00am on Tuesday 31 March 2026 but no later than 4.00pm on Thursday 9 April 2026 (excluding weekends and bank holidays).
3. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday 7 May 2026.
4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Monday 20 April 2026. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.
5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Town Hall, Rose Hill, Chesterfield, Derbyshire, S40 1LP by 5.00pm on Tuesday 21 April 2026.
6. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5.00pm on Tuesday 28 April 2026. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate>.
7. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Town Hall, Rose Hill, Chesterfield, Derbyshire, S40 1LP by 5.00pm on Tuesday 28 April 2026.
8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Town Hall, Rose Hill, Chesterfield, Derbyshire, S40 1LP by 5.00pm on Thursday 7 May 2026. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5.00pm on Tuesday 28 April 2026. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5.00pm on Tuesday 28 April 2026.
