1.	<p>Welcome, apologies and introductions</p> <p>DS welcomed all to the meeting and thanked the Football club for hosting.</p> <p>Apologies were noted.</p>

4.	<p>Update on LTPT programe</p> <p>LW advised that an update is still required on the LTPT programme. More information is anticipated as part of the Government's Autumn Statement. LW advised that Minister Norris had hosted a drop in session with MP's of LTPT towns. She also referred to a positive meeting held between Chesterfield LTPT Board representatives</p>	

	<p>and MHCLG colleagues around some of the policy challenges.</p> <p>TP confirmed that he attended the meeting with Minister Norris. Feedback was that the Chesterfield Plan had been well received.</p> <p>DS thanked TP and LW for their updates and asked the Board to give some consideration to what Plan B might look like if the LTPT is cancelled, being reflective of the amount of excellent work and engagement that has been undertaken as part of the process.</p> <p>CR highlighted the excellent engagement undertaken and suggested that the Board may consider presenting to EMMCA.</p>	
5.	<p>Focus on Safety and Security Theme</p> <p>DS introduced representatives from Chesterfield Borough Council, Chesterfield Community Trust and Derbyshire Constabulary who were in attendance to lead a session on Safety and Security theme.</p> <p>The Board received a presentation setting the scene and context for the theme, before undertaking workshop discussions to help prioritise future investment. Workshop outputs will be circulated to the Board separately.</p>
