Council Tax

Electoral register

Update your address online at **www.gov.uk/register-to-vote**, call **01246 345402** or **01246 345507** or email **elections@chesterfield.gov.uk**

Housing benefit

If you get Housing Benefit you need to stop any benefit being paid on your old address and claim at your new address. Call **01246 345345** or visit our website for more information.

Royal Mail

Your mail can be redirected from your old home address to your new home for a small charge. For details call **0345 7777 888** or visit the Post Office website.

Telephone and broadband provider

Don't forget to let us know if you have a new phone number.

TV Licensing

Visit **www.tvlicensing.co.uk** or call **0300 790 6144** to let them know about your change of address or to purchase a new tv licence.

Universal Credit

Universal Credit claims for housing costs can't be made until the day your tenancy officially starts. You can report your change of address through your universal credit account online. Speak to your Work Coach for assistance.
